## **Robert F Craig Acting President**

Effective immediately, Robert F Craig, [an Omaha, Nebraska lawyer](#), was named Acting President of the International Association of Insurance Fraud Agencies (IAIFA). After the resignation of Dr. Bassel Hindawi from his post at the Insurance Commission of Jordan, Bob Craig took over as the Acting President in addition to his Vice President duties of the Association. Mr. Craig brings many years of experience to this post having served ten years on IAIFA’s advisory committee as well as serving as IAIFA’s General Counsel, a position, which he retains.
